OUR SHIP SAILS THROUGH THE PANDEMIC

The second wave of the Covid-19 pandemic presented us with unique challenges. However, we ensured that the students remain engaged with their curricular activities. Furthermore, we provided counselling sessions to children to help them cope with any mental stress induced by the pandemic. Our teachers conducted online classes regularly and the progress of each student was monitored. Regular in-person classes started for senior students from July 2021 and all students with effective from August 2021.

BRIGHT KIDS FOUNDATION (BKF) is a registered charity trust under the Mumbai Charity Commission Act 1950. The donors of Bright Kids Foundation are eligible to claim tax exemption as per the provision of Income Tax Act 1961- India. A donation certificate is issued instantly on receipt of a donation with all 80G details. The aim of our foundation is to use 100% donation money towards the mission cause, as all administrative expenses are borne by the Founder/Trustee members of the Foundation.

ROADMAP FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2022 -23

INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS – School With A Difference (SWD) -GORAI LOCATION – The selection of SWD's Gorai location has been a success considering the fact that we have now 107 students from deserving families from std kg to 10th. Additionally, we are now teaching students from 11th grade to graduation in the SWD centre. Our volunteers who are professionals have taken up the task of providing academic coaching for various subjects like Economics, Accounts, English and Personality Development.

SKILL, EDUCATION & VOCATIONAL COURSES – We started sponsoring school and college dropouts to get back to earning a livelihood by enrolling them in courses like ECCED (Early Child Care and Education), Mehendi, Beauty, Administrative, Technical, Accounting software and Electrician courses.

SPORTS – We plan to introduce more sports activities for our students by doing a detailed feasibility study type of sports and appointing a good coach. SWD is very clear that sports are essential for a holistic education benefiting the child's mental and physical health.

MENTORING OF COLLEGE STUDENTS - We started Sunday classes for 3 hours for the college students who are sponsored by Bright Kids Foundation. These classes not only focus on academic subjects like Economics and Accounting but also emphasise the importance of Personality Development and English communication skills. Students are mentored to learn skills like public speaking, think out of the box and how to be a valuable citizen.



SCHOOL WITH A DIFFERENCE (SWD) - GORAI BORIVALI, MUMBAI

We are located at Gorai Borivali West. We at BKF conceptualised this term 'School with a Difference' and over the past few years have truly tried to uphold the meaning of it.

The premises have the following facilities:

- Library and computer rooms
- Spacious classrooms, a staffroom, clean washrooms, and clean drinking water facility
- A private area for visitors to interact with staff
- A special area for activities like yoga and dancing


BKF SWD ONLINE TEACHING SYSTEM

SWD TRANSITION TO CLASSROOM TEACHING

From June 10th, 2021 we restarted in person classes in our Gorai centre for standard 8th to 10th. Two school vans were used to transport students from Poinsur (old location) to Gorai (new location). Each van was running 8-10 trips per day to comply with Covid-19 regulations. In August 2021 we purchased a 21-seater bus (sponsored by SBIMF) which helped us to continue our regular classes.

Following measures were implemented in view of the pandemic and were followed very strictly.

- Using masks, sanifizer and frequently washing hands was compulsory
- Only 2 students per bench were seated
- To avoid overcrowding, classes were conducted for few standards on alternate days









CSR AUDIT

BKF SWD sponsor CAMS assigned a 3rd party consultant Auxo Hub to have a compliance audit to analyse, review and appraise our charity and to justify the CSR donations utilisation. A team of 2 people conducted the audit of BKF – SWD Gorai on 4th Feb 2022 through zoom meetings due to Covid restrictions. Various aspects of teaching, student's performance, activities done and student's response were analysed and submitted to the sponsors.



ACTIVITIES

WELL-BEING OF CHILDREN

Sports and other forms of physical activities form an essential part of BKF curriculum. Hence, we introduced Yoga, Wellness, Meditation, Concentration and Breathing activities. These activities are aimed at boosting immunity and improving mental health of children.



SURVEYING OF OLD STUDENTS & VETTING OF NEW STUDENTS

We conducted a survey for getting new students from the area around our SWD centre in Gorai. We also did the vetting process of students from Gorai who were already enrolled with us. This was simultaneously done in the month of April before the start of the second Covid wave. This is to ensure that this facility is only being used by deserving students as per BKF policy and the necessary actions were taken.









COUNSELLING AND REMEDIAL EDUCATION

Weekly sessions were organized for all students. Individual counselling sessions were also given to students who needed special attention. Group sessions were conducted for students on various topics like memory enhancement, concentration, study pattern and techniques, encouragement for reading and writing, nonverbal communication and creative thinking.





UNIFORM DISTRIBUTION

Founders Mrs. Jaya Balachandran & Mrs, Lakshmi Nair donated BKF's uniform to all students.







COMPUTER EDUCATION

The world has turned digital and everything is shifting to online platforms. Therefore, it was highly essential to introduce computers and computer software skills to all students. Two desktops and two laptops along with computer desks and chairs were received through donations. Relevant videos are shown to students so they can easily relate to the education provided to them. Computer lessons are provided to the students and they have access to Wi-Fi. Project-based assignments are given to students to enable research and thinking processes. We aim to run the donation drive to arrange for more computers to help the computer literacy amongst BKF students.





OTHER ACTIVITIES

At BKF we conduct the following sessions for the students.

- 1. **Cleaning Session:** Once a month we conduct a cleaning drive at BKFSWD to inculcate the habit of cleanliness in students and make them understand the importance of cleanliness.
- Student Feedback Session: Anonymous surveys are conducted to get students feedback on BKF and its activities. The feedback is shared with the sponsors. We endeavour to conduct similar feedback sessions every year for improving our faculty and facility. Based on the survey 98% of the students were happy to attend BKF SWD centre.
- 3. **Practical knowledge banking activities:** We conducted a detailed session on bank transaction, filing deposit slip form and cheque writing. This has helped students to be aware and be hands on during hours of need.
